Reservations must be received by March 19, 2009 to ensure room availability.

A deposit of the first night's room and tax is due upon booking a reservation. There will be a \$35 non-refundable pet deposit per room. Cancellations of individual rooms must occur 10 days prior to April 2nd.

If cancellation is not made before the above date, the deposit may be forfeited.

DCA Hotel Policy

"Any exhibitor who allows his/her dogs to be loose and unattended in a room or to damage hotel property and does NOT immediately contact the hotel management to make proper restitution, will be subject to Show Committee action which could result in the loss of AKC privileges."

If it is determined by the Committee hearing that the rules are being neglected and destruction and/or misuse of property is taking place, the Committee has the authority to correct the problem or seek AKC suspension.

Additional Hotel Rules

1. Dogs left unattended in hotel rooms must be in crates.
2. The maximum number of dogs in a room is four (4).
3. Housekeeping must be allowed to clean a guest room (with dogs) at least every two days. Guests who have special requests can discuss them with the staff upon arrival.
4. Bathing dogs in rooms is prohibited! Owners should bring their own towel for bathing the dog at a designated area on the show grounds.
5. The individual guest will be responsible for any damage to a guest room or any hotel property. This includes, but is not limited to, replacement of carpets, if odors or stains cannot be removed with traditional cleaning methods. It would be wise to check your room before moving in for any pre-existing damage, and report it immediately to housekeeping or the front desk.
6. Dogs should be on leashes at all times when not in guest rooms.
7. Dogs will not be allowed in certain designated areas or around the pool or in restaurants.



RV Information

There is limited RV parking at the Holiday Inn. The parking lot is capable of accommodating 25 rigs. Once this limit is reached, we cannot take any more reservations and there will be no other RV parking at this hotel. The cost per night is \$25. All RV parking is dry camping. There are no hook-ups or facilities for dumping at this site. Arrive with full fuel and water tanks and empty holding tanks for maximum convenience. A sanitation truck will visit about mid-week. The cost of this service will be \$ 25 per unit and will be payable to DCA with your reservation. Campers who order sanitation service on site will incur an additional charge.

Rigs can be serviced with water ONE time during the week for a charge of \$20 per rig. A crew of men will water all rigs. The cost of watering is payable to DCA with your RV reservation. Campers who order water on site will incur an additional charge.

All campers are expected to keep their campsites clean and orderly and leave them in as good a shape as they found them. Absolutely no dumping of gray or black water tanks under penalty of state and local laws and an AKC bench show action.

After our limit has been reached, reservations can be made at the Lawrence KOA which is located 1.3 miles from the hotel. (785)842-3877.

Advertise Your Best Photograph

Include Instructions

Do not bend, fold, tape, or staple photographs to artwork. Include a photocopy marked "sample." Be sure all photos and artwork are labeled.

Keep It Simple

Don't try to cram too much information in one ad. Give emphasis to the dog and the owner's name.

Note The Ad's Dimensions

The catalog will be spiral bound pages with ad page space of 7 1/4" x 4 1/2" (Half page size: 3 5/8" x 4 1/2"). Draw this on a piece of paper and place your ad on it to see how things fit.

Electronic Files

Ads should be submitted on disk. File can be accepted in either Macintosh or PC format. Files can be in Quark, Illustrator, Freehand, or Photoshop. Ads can be submitted on zip, cd-rom or 3.5" floppy.
